Explore history from Civil War to Cold War

- March 5, 1946, President Harry S Truman hosted **Sir Winston Churchill** at Fulton's Westminster College. Churchill's address, known as the "Iron Curtain Speech," marked the start of the Cold War. The **National Churchill Museum** is housed under **St. Mary the Virgin Aldermanbury**, a Christopher Wren church brought over from London. A sculpture crafted from the **Berlin Wall** marks the end of the Cold War.

- Step back in time at **Crane's Country Store and Crane's Museum**, a collection that tells the story of pioneer life from the late 1800s to early 1900s.

- Enjoy the historic architecture, brick streets, old fashioned soda fountain, galleries, shops and restaurants in Fulton's charming **Brick District**.

- **Backer Auto World** celebrates America's love affair with automobiles. Nearly 80 rare vehicles displayed.

Savor the best of America's Heartland

- **Canterbury Hill** and **Serenity Valley Wineries** offer a selection of murder mysteries, wine tastings, dining, wine bottling and custom labeling parties.

- A variety of restaurants offer quality meals at hometown prices: a college dining hall that students call "Hogwarts" in honor of Harry Potter books, family style fixings at Crane's Country Museum and fine dining at a bluff-top winery. Or try one of the **Brick District's** options: a chef-owned restaurant, a casual bistro in an historic theatre, a bar and grill in an old post office, a New York pizzeria or a cafe that specializes in Cuban food.

- **Central Missouri Meat and Sausage** offers locally-sourced, high quality meats and hand-crafted brats, summer sausages and snack sticks. Products are free of antibiotics, hormones, gluten, nitrates and artificial preservatives.

Hermann and Fulton – A perfect pairing. Two-day itinerary:

DAY ONE:

- **Morning:** Arrive in Hermann, home of Missouri's German heritage and wine renaissance. Pick two sites from German School Museum, Duetschheim State Historic Site homes, Living History Farm and Our Lady of Sorrows Shrine.

- **Lunch:** Choose from a German concert hall, restaurant at Stone Hill Winery, an historic inn or other dining options.

- **Afternoon:** Narrated city tour with shopping and sausage tasting. Visit a selection of wineries, culminating with a tour of Stone Hill Winery's vaulted cellars, tasting room and gift shop.

- **Evening:** Depart Hermann for Fulton. Stop for dinner at Marlene's at Crane's Country Store and Museum in Williamsburg.

- Overnight in your choice of group friendly hotels in Kingdom City or Fulton. Welcome reception and musical entertainment available.

DAY TWO:

- **Morning:** Explore nearly 80 rare and historic vehicles at Backer Auto World. Experience the National Churchill Museum, located under a Sir Christopher Wren Church brought over London. Enjoy a concert on the massive pipe organ and outdoor sculpture crafted from sections of the Berlin Wall.

- **Lunch:** Options include "Hogwarts" dining hall at Westminster College, bluff top winery, an old post office, Brooklyn-style pizzeria, bbq joint, Cuban cafe and more.

- **Afternoon:** Choose between browsing the historic Brick District, a fun art or craft event, visiting a barnwood furniture studio, antiquing or a seasonal activity such as a haywagon ride.
